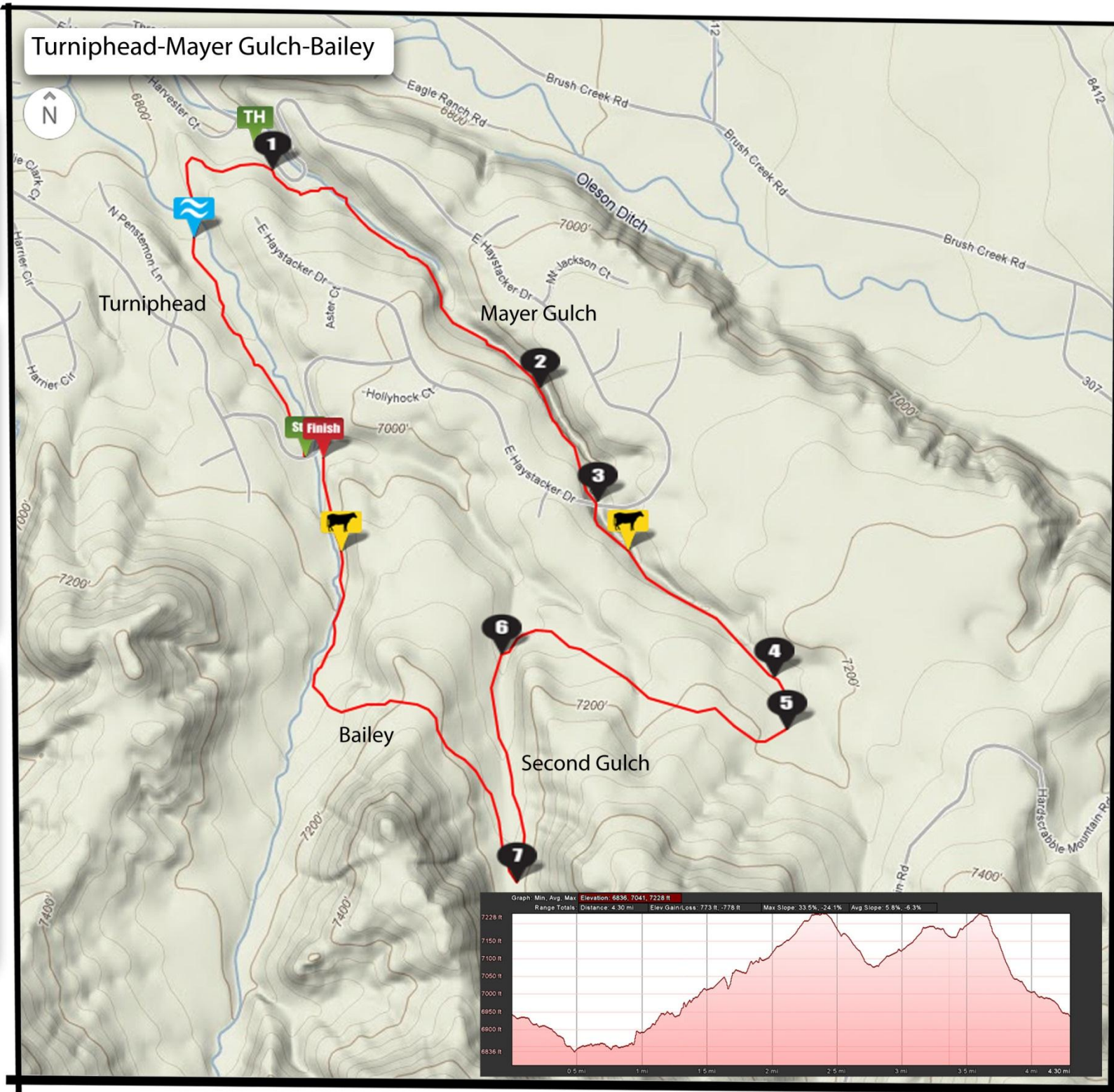

 - 5 Turn right at intersection 2.20
 - 6 Turn left at intersection 2.86
 - 7 Turn right onto single track 3.29
CATTLE GUARD 4.15
- END Ride ends at Arroyo Drive 4.33

This trail is a great introduction to hiking in Eagle. Along with Riddle/Wall this trail offers some of what Eagle has to offer, all within a short, closed loop. Descending Turniphead is a fun, easy single track. After crossing the creek on the bridge provided the trail makes a short climb. At the intersection with Mayer Gulch the trail begins a long, steady climb up Mayer Gulch. Beware of downhill riders while climbing. The trail has a short downhill around the 2.5 mile mark and then slowly climbs Second Gulch. Bailey offers first a semi-steep climb and then a steep downhill section that brings the hiker back to the parking area.



1 Arroyo Drive Parking

0190 Arroyo Drive

Take I-70 Exit 147. Turn left on Eby Creek Rd. At the traffic circle, take first exit onto Grand Ave. At the traffic circle, take the third exit onto Sylvan Lake Rd. Turn right on Eagle Ranch Rd. Turn right on Fourth of July Rd. Turn left on Arroyo Dr. to the parking lot and trailhead.
